

Labeling Regulation (EU) No 1169/2011

Regulation (EU) No 1169/2011

In accordance with Articles 10 to 35 and subject to the exceptions contained in this Chapter, indication of the following particulars shall be mandatory: (a) the name of the food; (b) the list of ingredients; (c) any ingredient or processing aid listed in Annex II or derived from a substance or product listed in Annex II causing allergies or intolerances used in the manufacture or preparation of a food and still present in the finished product, even if in an altered form; (d) the quantity of certain ingredients or categories of ingredients; (e) the net quantity of the food; (f) the date of minimum durability or the 'use by' date; (g) any special storage conditions and/or conditions of use; (h) the name or business name and address of the food business operator referred to in Article 8(1); (i) the country of origin or place of provenance where provided for in Article 26; (j) instructions for use where it would be difficult to make appropriate use of the food in the absence of such instructions

(k) with respect to beverages containing more than 1,2 % by volume of alcohol, the actual alcoholic strength by volume

Article 30 Content 1.

The mandatory nutrition declaration shall include the following: Nutritional values, Ingredients Allergens in bold





Art 16- 4. Without prejudice to other Union provisions requiring a list of ingredients or a mandatory nutrition declaration, the particulars referred to in points (b) and (l) of Article 9(1) **shall not be mandatory for beverages containing more than 1,2 % by volume of alcohol. Article 41** Alcoholic beverages Member States may, pending the adoption of the Union provisions referred to in Article 16(4), maintain national measures as regards the listing of ingredients in the case of beverages containing more than 1,2 % by volume of alcohol.



In March 2015 brewers announced a commitment to progressively implementing ingredients listing and nutrition information of beers across the EU, following the rules as laid down in Regulation (EU) No 1169/2011.


